Er-wei Bai was educated at Fudan University and Shanghai Jiaotong University, both in Shanghai China. He received his PhD degree from University of California at Berkeley. He is currently Professor of Electrical and Computer Engineering, and of Radiology at the University of Iowa, Iowa City, Iowa, USA. He is also World Class Research Professor, School of Electronics, Electrical Engineering and Computer Science at Queen's University, Belfast, UK. His research areas are in identification, signal processing, control and their applications in engineering

and life science problems.

He has served as an associate editor for a number of journals and as a member of technical committees for professional societies. He is a recipient of the Presidential Award for Teaching Excellence and the Board of Regents Award for Faculty Excellence. Dr. Bai has published extensively in the areas and is a Fellow of IEEE.
