Gang Feng received the B.Eng and M.Eng. degrees in Automatic Control from Nanjing Aeronautical Institute, China in 1982 and in 1984 respectively, and the Ph.D. degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Melbourne, Australia in 1992.

He has been with City University of Hong Kong since 2000 where he is now a Chair Professor of Mechatronic Engineering. He was also a ChangJiang Chair Professor at Nanjing University of Science and Technology, awarded by Ministry of Education, China. He was lecturer/senior lecturer at School of Electrical Engineering, University of New South Wales, Australia, 1992-1999. He was

awarded an Alexander von Humboldt Fellowship in 1997-1998, and the IEEE Transactions on Fuzzy Systems Outstanding Paper Award in 2007. He has authored/co-authored over 200 international journal papers including over 90 in IEEE Transactions and numerous conference papers. His current research interests include intelligent systems & control, networked systems & control, and multi-agent systems & control.

Prof. Feng is an IEEE Fellow, an associate editor of *IEEE Transactions on Fuzzy Systems*, and was an associate editor of *IEEE Transactions on Automatic Control, IEEE Transactions on Systems, Man & Cybernetics, Part C, Mechatronics*, and *Journal of Control Theory and Applications*.
